## **2018 Huronia Stallions House League Equipment Schedule**

**DATE:** Friday, April 20<sup>th</sup>.

LOCATION: Barrie Sports Complex – Change rooms near football field

**TIME:** Your players' equipment time is dependent upon the division in which they are playing in and their last name so please look at schedule carefully. Please only come at your scheduled time as the change room is small.

TIME	DIVISION	PLAYERS' LAST NAME
3:00 – 5:00	All Divisions	A-Z
6:00 – 7:00	Mustang	A-Z
7:00 – 8:00	Pony	A-Z
8:00 – 9:00	Colt	A-Z

**NOTE:** If you have more than one player playing, and they are in different divisions, please bring both players in the youngest players scheduled time. We will fit both players at the same time so parents need not make multiple trip to the sports complex.

**EXAMPLE:** Johnny Apple and Todd Apple are brothers and both playing. Johnny is mustang and Todd is a Colt. Johnny and Todd would come in the mustang pick up time (6:00-7:00). Both Johnny and Todd will be fitted at the same time. If for some reason your player cannot pick up equipment during their scheduled time on April 20<sup>th</sup> you must contact the house league coordinator, through email at huroniastallions@hotmail.ca.

## **REMINDERS:**

- Please bring a \$100 cash deposit for the equipment. This deposit will be returned when the equipment is returned at the end of the season.
- Dress your player in shorts and t-shirt if possible. It is easier to size equipment if player is not wearing big bulky clothes. Leave baseball hats in the car.
- No Parents in the equipment room please. Players will line up outside the equipment room in single file. They will enter the equipment room and about 10 minutes later exit with full gear.

## **EQUIPMENT NOTES:**

- Do not attempt to adjust or alter the equipment in any way. A member of the Huronia Stallions Coaching Staff should complete all adjustments.
- Football equipment is designed to fit a little snug (helmets included)
- Mouth guards are a mandatory piece of equipment. Your player will be supplied with 1 mouthguard. This mouth guard should be molded using hot water and attached to the helmet using the tether. This should be completed for the first practice, May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
